Five Paragraph Essay Question: WHG Rev. 2/25/11

Steps in writing a five-paragraph essay:

- a. Carefully read the question.
- b. Find the requirements, and decide how you will answer them in the middle 3 paragraphs.
- c. Paragraph 1: This is the introductory paragraph. 1st) Find the topic sentence of the question, and use it or paraphrase it. 2nd) State the main idea of your essay in a thesis statement. 3rd) briefly summarize the main points you will make in the next three paragraphs. 4th) Try to have a transition word, phrase, or sentence between paragraphs.
- d. Paragraphs 2, 3, 4: This is the meat of the essay. Begin each paragraph with a topic sentence similar to how you described this paragraph in the introduction. Follow with supporting sentences.
- e. Paragraph 5: This is the conclusion of the essay. Begin by restating your thesis, and then state how your main points supported the thesis.
