Current Events Assignments World History & Geography 2 Rev.6/60/01

1. Research:

Research a current event based on the assigned topic. Anything which has occurred within a year will qualify as a current event. Sources for your research should be print media and might include the Internet, news magazines or newspapers.

Your event should be important to people here in the United States. Do not report on an event which would be significant only within the other country, such as a bus going off a bridge or the death of a local official. If you are using an Internet news source, be sure to use an established and reliable source such as the *Christian Science Monitor*, *USA Today*, *the Denver Post*, ABC News, CNN, *Time* or *Newsweek*.

2. Report:

In paragraph form, write a report on your current event answering the following questions: What, Who, When, Where, Why, How? Your report should not be in the form of a list.

3. Proper English:

Your report should be a minimum of one paragraph in length (at least four sentences). It should begin with a topic sentence followed by supporting information.

Use good sentences (no run-ons or fragments) with proper spelling, grammar, and punctuation.

4. Attach your printed source material to your report to hand in. Be sure to include the source (news organization) of the material.
